# Global Education, Teaching & Learning Conference 2019 Šibenik (Croatia)

Sep 25<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019

**Conference theme: Challenging the Underlying Assumptions of Educational Systems**  
**Hosted by: Innovation Institute**

### Conference Purpose and Objectives

Global Education, Teaching & Learning Conference 2019 focuses on exploring and challenging the assumptions that underlie the way educational systems are structured and changing. As knowledge dissemination is crucial for the future of humanity, it is paramount to question diverse beliefs we take for granted. Numerous questions arise: How is/should an educational system be structured? What should it focus on? How should it evolve with the development of artificially intelligent systems? Assumptions that we often take for granted, significantly shape our present and the future. We would like to use GETL Conference 2019 as a platform for discussions on how to structure educational systems (at different levels) in order to deliver greatest value for an individual, but also humanity.

Conference welcomes both theoretical and empirical contributions, from those which are in an idea stage to those that are fully developed manuscripts. We also welcome different formats for publication in the proceedings: from abstracts, which indicate the direction, to full papers. Conference proceedings (with ISSN) will be published by Innovation Institute. Besides its interdisciplinarity, this conference wants to provide a platform for constructive dialogue on these important issues.

### Venue

Conference will be held in Šibenik in Solaris Resort. Šibenik is a historic town of Croatia and it is located in central Dalmatia. Unlike other cities along the Adriatic coast, which were established by Greeks, Illyrians and/or Romans, Šibenik was the first Croatian city originally founded by Slavs in 11<sup>th</sup> century. It was mentioned for the first time under its present name in 1066 in a Charter of the Croatian King Petar Kresimir IV and, for a period of time, it was a seat of this Croatian King.

Today Šibenik is a very popular touristic destination because of its cultural heritage (the Cathedral of St. James built from 1431 and 1536 is on the UNESCO World Heritage list), natural beauties (National parks Kornati and Krka) and well known Mediterranean



cuisine. Šibenik is a home town of Drazen Petrovic (NBA basketball player), Faust Vrancic (parachute inventor), Goran Visnjic (Hollywood actor) and Maksim Mrvica (world known piano player).

The county of Šibenik has 242 islands, islets and rocks. Most of this archipelago lies in the north-west part of Šibenik's waters and is very indented, bare and sparsely inhabited. The most numerous group of islands are the National park Kornati. The Kornati archipelago consists of 150 islands in a sea area of about 320 km<sup>2</sup>, making it the densest archipelago in the Mediterranean Sea, widely known for their bizarre shapes and luxurious and magnificent landscapes.



## Submission Guidelines

Global Education, Teaching & Learning Conference 2019 invites submissions of abstracts/papers that provide insights into key research challenges. Submissions should be uploaded in Word format (.doc or .docx file) at [Paper Submission](#) web site no later than June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Your paper should not exceed 5.000 words and if you would like to submit only an abstract it should not exceed 250 words. Your contribution should be written in English and submitted on time.

Authors should **indicate the track in which they would like to present their contribution**. Each contribution can be submitted only to one track. In order to include your contribution in the conference and the proceedings **at least one author per accepted manuscript must register for the conference**.

Contributions will go through a double blind review process. **Letter of acceptance or rejection will be e-mailed out within 7 working days** from your submission. For details please visit official web site of the conference: [www.getlconference.com](http://www.getlconference.com).
