Conference Purpose and Objectives

Global Education, Teaching & Learning Conference 2021 focuses on exploring and questioning whether the new ways of education, teaching and learning will become the standard way. The last 12 months have been challenging for all industries, but education has been one of the most affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. Established ways of education and learning were no longer possible and everything was shifted to an online environment. By finding a vaccine and hoping that the health situation will improve, the question arises as to whether the education industry will return to the old (postulates that were valid before the pandemic) or will continue in a new way. All stakeholders should be included - users, providers, government, competition, environment, companies, etc. We would like to use 2021 GETL Conference as a platform for discussions on how to structure educational systems (at different levels) in order to deliver greatest value for an individual, but also humanity.

Conference welcomes both theoretical and empirical contributions, from those which are in an idea stage to those that are fully developed manuscripts. We also welcome different formats for publication: from abstracts, which indicate the direction, to full papers. Conference proceedings (with ISSN) will be published by Innovation Institute. Besides its interdisciplinarity, this conference wants to provide a platform for constructive dialogue on these important issues

Venue

Conference will be held in Zagreb - the capital and the largest city of the Republic of Croatia. The name Zagreb was mentioned for the first time in 1094, and it became a free royal town in 1242. Through history, as it is today, Zagreb was political and administrative center of Croatia. Today, Zagreb is modern European city with lot of green areas, squares, museums and vivid night life.

In past few years, Zagreb became popular tourist destination especially for those how want to experience typical European city with long history, great gastronomy and enjoyable people.



Only two hours from Zagreb is located one of Croatian most known marks – National Park Plitvice Lakes. It is one of the oldest national parks in Europe and from 1979 Plitvice Lakes are on UNESCO World Heritage list. Plitvice Lakes are world famous for its lakes arranged in cascades – currently there is 16 lakes that can be seen from the surface with lot of waterfalls (the largest waterfall is 78m). If it will be possible due to Covid-19, on the last day of the conference we will be visiting Plitvice Lakes.



Submission Guidelines

Global Education, Teaching & Learning Conference 2021 invites submissions of abstracts/papers that provide insights into key research challenges. Submissions should be uploaded in Word format (.doc or .docx file) at [Paper Submission](#) web site no later than August 1st, 2021. Your paper should not exceed 5.000 words and if you would like to submit only an abstract it should not exceed 250 words. Your contribution should be written in English, submitted on time and be relevant with the overall conference theme objectives

Authors should **indicate the track in which they would like to present their contribution**. Each contribution can be submitted only to one track. In order to include your contribution in the conference and the proceedings **at least one author per accepted manuscript must register for the conference**.

Contributions will go through a double-blind review process. **Letter of acceptance or rejection will be e-mailed out within 7 working days** from your submission. For details please visit official web site of the conference www.getlconference.com.
